- To increase the number of nurse aides available to work in Wisconsin nursing homes
- **To inform the public** about the benefits of working in a Wisconsin nursing home and the opportunity to make a difference

WisCAREGIVERS as of 1/31/19

- 6,177 Participants initially registered in WisCaregiver Careers
- 1,242 Participants dis-enrolled in WisCaregiver Careers*
- **1,696** WisCaregivers enrolled in nurse aide training
- 1,166 WisCaregivers completed nurse aide training
 - 689 WisCaregivers completed testing
 - 243 WisCaregivers employed in a Wisconsin nursing home
