

#### 2017 Calendar Year Report on Opioid Treatment Programs in Wisconsin

In 2017, there were 18 clinics in Wisconsin that met the definition of an opioid treatment program (OTP) under 42 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 8. An OTP is an accredited treatment program with the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration certification and the Drug Enforcement Administration registration to administer and dispense medications that are approved by Food and Drug and Administration (FDA) to treat opioid addiction. Currently, these include methadone and buprenorphine products. Other pharmacotherapies, such as naltrexone, may be provided but are not subject to these regulations. OTPs must provide adequate medical, counseling, vocational, educational, and other assessment and treatment services either onsite or by referral to an outside agency or practitioner through a formal agreement. The use of FDA-approved medications in combination with other supports to provide a whole-patient approach to services for opioid addiction is known as medication-assisted treatment.

The State Opioid Treatment Authority in the Division of Care and Treatment Services oversees the operation of these privately owned and operated clinics.

This report provides one page summaries for each OTP. The summaries include the data points required

to be reported to DHS under Wis. Stat. § 51.4223. The Division of Care and Treatment Services also requested each OTP to report additional data points. All OTPs complied with these data requests.

The total number of people served at OTPs in Wisconsin has increased steadily in the last four years as the misuse and abuse of opioids became a public health crisis. In 2017, a total of 10,626 individuals received services from an OTP in Wisconsin.

Wisconsin OTPs are required to comply with Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 75.15 regarding the ratio of treatment program staff to the number of patients receiving treatment. If at any

time the clinic is out of compliance with this requirement, they are placed on an admission hold until they come back into compliance with the ratio requirement.

Each OTP has a plan for tapering individuals off methadone. The taper plan varies by individual and is based on their circumstances.
